

WHAT IS THE YPC Fast Track Program?

The YPC Fast Track Program provides a broader group of donors with the opportunity to participate in a “step-up” leadership giving program. Individuals/ Couples may join YPC by giving \$500 during the first year of membership with a commitment to step up to the \$1,000 Leadership level by the third year of membership. The step-up schedule is \$500 the first year, \$750 in year two, and \$1,000 by year three.

Fast Track members enjoy the same opportunities as YPC members including attending Breakfast with a Leader and other social events. Listing in the UWBB’s Leadership Roster is reserved for the third year of membership.

MENTORSHIP PROGRAM- Connects YPC members with UWBB Tocqueville Society and Board members through a one-year mentor-based relationship. YPC members will also have the opportunity to mentor a member of FSU's Student United Way. Members must meet certain eligibility criteria to participate in this program.
