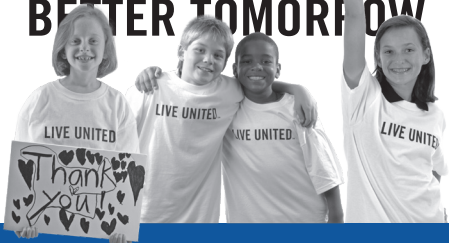

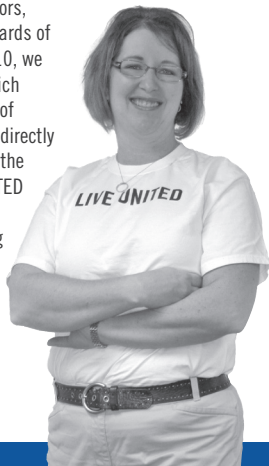

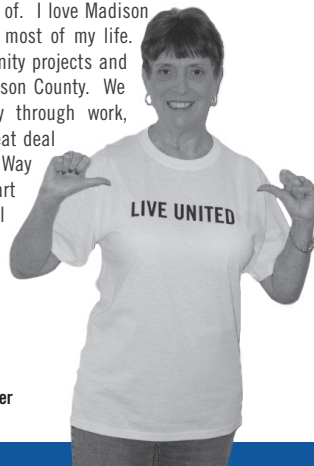


ADVOCATE.

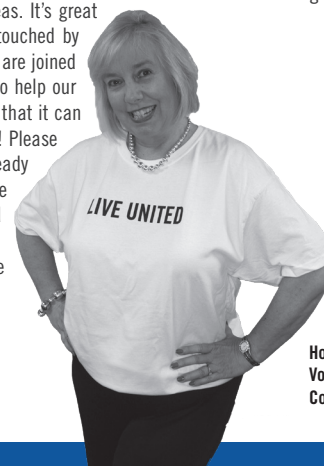
