For a community to flourish, its members must be healthy. United Way of the Big Bend's Health Council is committed to building a culture where getting healthy and staying healthy are top priorities. We are focused on improving the health of children and families through partnerships that promote mental and physical well-being for all. **SMILE UNITED** is one example. A school-based pediatric dental program focused on tooth decay prevention, **SMILE UNITED** provides FREE dental screenings, oral cleanings, sealants, fluoride varnish, oral health instruction, and personal dental kits to students attending Leon and Gadsden County Title I schools. Another example is UWBB's partnership with 2-1-1 Big Bend and the FSU College of Medicine to create a Mental Health Resource Directory and support system in an effort to improve access for mental health services and treatment.
