Sarah was determined to keep her two siblings from entering foster care. Her mother had passed away, and they were removed from their disabled father's custody.

Though she had four children of her own, she took them in; she knew her mother would have wanted it that way.

Sarah panicked as she read a letter taped to her front door. The letter stated she was being evicted because there were too many people living in her apartment.

Since she did not have legal custody of her siblings, she was not eligible for a larger unit. Sarah also learned that without custody, she could not receive additional resources from the state for the children's basic needs.

Sarah was referred to a United Way partner program that works to keep families in their homes. They were assigned a case manager, who immediately secured clothing and additional food for the children. The case manager also worked with the state and was able to help Sarah obtain temporary custody. Soon, she moved her family into a four-bedroom apartment and enrolled the children in the neighborhood school.
