• Childcare Tuition Assistance – An Early Learning Coalition of the Big Bend, Inc., program providing tuition assistance for families of young children enrolled in high quality learning environments. This program specifically targets ALICE families and allows parents to work knowing their children are in a positive educational environment. \$1,609

 Food Bank Operations – An America's Second Harvest of the Big Bend program to meet the short-term nutritional needs of the hungry, food-insecure people in Liberty County. Food assistance can also help families to pay for other expenses such as medicines, school expenses, rent, and utilities. \$1,608
